RoHS2

Directive 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU Regarding Restriction of Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment

RoHS2 Directive was introduced June 8th, 2011 by European Unit and took effect on July 21st, 2011. Its main objective is to address concerns related to certain hazardous substances that may be utilized in the manufacture of electrical and electronic equipment as well as their components, including cables.

Based upon a diligent inquiry, we do not have reason to believe that our suppliers or ourselves, during the assembly and production process; use any substances regulated by the RoHS2 Directive. We therefore declare that items supplied by FlexLink do not reach the required level of disclosure under RoHS2.

This declaration applies to all amendments to the Directive as of the date of this letter including 2015/863/EU.

FlexLink does not declare RoHS2 compliance for materials altered by third parties (e.g. modifications, assembly or fabrication with other materials and products).
