

Regulation Compliance Statement

REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006

REACH is a regulation of the European Union concerning the Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemical substances. The purpose of this regulation is to limit the use of substances that may severely affect either people's health, their safety or the environment and to ensure that information regarding the safe use of these chemical substances is passed on to its customers in a correct and timely manner.

FlexLink is not a manufacturer nor an importer of Chemical Substances being regulated by REACH: according to REACH regulation EC 1907/2006 Articles 3(3) and 3 (33), FlexLink' role is considered to be an *Importer of Articles* and a *Distributor*; under the definition of the REACH regulations EC1907/2006 Article 7(1).

FlexLink products are "articles" as defined in REACH Article 3(3) and do not release substances under their normal or reasonable or foreseeable conditions of use. FlexLink understands that suppliers of articles must provide recipients with information on Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) if those are present above a concentration limit of 0.1% on an article level.

FlexLink products do not contain any of the currently listed SVHC's. FlexLink will continue to work with our suppliers to ensure that all SVHC's are notified to the European Chemicals Agency, when necessary, to comply with the REACH requirement.
