Directive 2015/863/EU Regarding Restriction of Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment

RoHS3 main objective is to address concerns related to certain hazardous substances that may be utilized in the manufacture of electrical and electronic equipment and sub/assemblies as well as their components, including cables.

Based upon a diligent investigation of our assembly and production process, we believe that we and our suppliers do not use any of the restricted substances regulated by the RoHS3 Directive. We therefore declare that items supplied by FlexLink do not reach the required level of disclosure under RoHS3.

This declaration applies to all amendments to the Directive 2015/863/EU as of the date of this letter.

FlexLink does not declare RoHS3 compliance for materials later altered by third parties (e.g. modifications, assembly or fabrication with other materials and products).
